- An American Legion Post, Unit, or Squadron must endorse the nominee (Squadrons may nominate but require a sponsoring post officer signature).
- The District Commander's endorsement. In the event there are multiple submissions for a district, it is the District Commander's responsibility to endorse the finalist for the district (one submission per district).
