Delegates & Alternates to the National Convention

Each department is entitled to:

- Five at-large delegates & alternates
- An additional delegate & alternate for each 1,000 members (or major fraction thereof) 30 days before the convention.

Other delegates:

- National Executive Committee Members
- Past National Commanders

Delegates & Alternates to the National Convention

The Department's five at-large delegates:

- Immediate Past Department Commander Delegation Chair
- Department Adjutant Delegation Secretary
- Department Commander
- Department Service Officer
- Department Finance Officer

Vacancies are filled by the Delegation Chair

Delegates & Alternates to the National Convention

The delegates & alternates for each 1,000 members (or major fraction thereof) are selected at the District Spring Conferences.

The number of delegates and alternates for each district is determined by the membership of the district.

Delegates & Alternates to the National Convention

Can I attend National Convention if I am not elected as a Delegate or Alternate?

Yes! You can attend National Convention as a Guest.

What happens if a district does not fill its delegates or alternates?

 Delegates, Alternates, and Guests from other districts move up to fill vacancies, pending approval from the District Commander, and ratification at Department Convention.


